

Lyme Disease Risk Areas in British Columbia

Note of context: in comparison to the high endemic rates of Lyme Disease in northeastern United States (29 cases per 100,000 population and 40% tick infection rate), the risk in BC is low (<0.5 cases per 100,000 population and <1% tick infection rate).

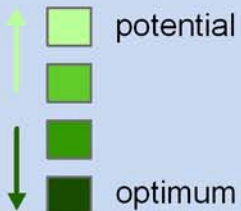
