Specific Immunocompromising Conditions

- Anatomic or Functional Asplenia
- Congenital Immunodeficiency States
- Hematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation (HSCT) and Chimeric Antigen Receptor T-cell (CART) Therapy
- Immunization of Pediatric Oncology Clients
- Approval for Immunization of Pediatric Oncology, HSCT and CART Therapy Clients Who Have Completed Treatment
- Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Infection
- Immunosuppressive Therapy
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic Liver Disease
- Adults with Malignant Neoplasm (Including Leukemia and Lymphoma)
- Candidate for or Recipient of Solid Organ or Islet Cell Transplant

Other High Risk Conditions

- Infants at High Risk for Hepatitis B
 - High Risk Neonatal Hepatitis B Immunization Program (Letter for Health Care Providers)
- Individuals with Bleeding Disorders
- Chronic Heart or Lung Disease
- Chronic Cerebrospinal Fluid (CSF) Leak
- Cochlear Implant
- Cystic Fibrosis
- Diabetes Mellitus
- Individuals with Neurologic Disorders

- People Who are Pregnant or Planning a Pregnancy
- Infants Born Prematurely

- Health Care Workers
- Childcare Workers
- Inmates of Provincial Correctional Institutions
- International Travelers
- Males Who Have Sexual Contact With Other Males
- Individuals New to Canada
- Unknown or Uncertain Immunization Status/Inadequate Immunization Records
