


# COVID-19 Entrance Screening Tool for Health-Care Facilities

## (For all staff, visitors and patients/clients/residents)

This tool is for screeners at health-care facility entrances to determine whether an individual poses a COVID-19 risk and whether they should be permitted to enter. This tool should be used in accordance with the provincial visitor policies as well as any employer workplace health and safety (WHS) policies. This tool is an example that can be adapted based on setting and specific services and is not intended to replace medical advice. Follow the arrows to use this tool (e.g., if the answer to Question 1 is "Yes", the other questions do not need to be answered).



**All persons entering a health-care facility must wear a mask in accordance with the [Provincial Mask Use in Health-Care Settings Policy](#).**

Individuals with symptoms compatible with COVID-19 who are NOT permitted to enter should be directed to call 8-1-1 or their health-care provider. **\*Does not apply** to children who are ineligible for the vaccine, those with an approved medical exemption, visitation for end-of-life care and in other specific care settings such as emergency rooms, intensive care units, pediatric care, labour and delivery.
