Proposed measures for assessing asymptomatic workers (not close contacts)

- Screening for symptoms
 - Implement or enhance active screening of onsite workers for symptoms
- Asymptomatic testing
 - Can assist with risk assessment, containment, measuring extent of the outbreak and identifying areas/groups at risk
 - Especially important when there is evidence of undetected spread, cases with unknown source or high risk exposures identified
 - Can be conducted in the teams/sites where cases have occurred and repeated or increased to larger/other groups if high prevalence detected
