

DOCUMENTATION FOR APPROVED EMERGENCY ON-FARM SLAUGHTER

British Columbia Meat Inspection Regulation

In accordance with the *Food Safety Act* and *Meat Inspection Regulation*, application is herewith made as set out below to undertake an emergency on-farm slaughter.

Note: carcasses will not be accepted at a licensed abattoir without prior notification by producer and approval by both plant operator and Inspector-in-Charge at the plant. Approval to ship carcass under the Meat Inspection Regulation does not convey other necessary approvals such as SRM transport permits (Call 1.800.442.2342 for emergency SRM permits).
