In 1977, Dr. Peter Hoogewerf, a visionary family physician in British Columbia, established Canada's first sentinel influenza surveillance network.

Since then, dedicated physicians across BC have contributed each year to help monitor the arrival, spread and health care impact of influenza.

In recent years, BC physicians have also become world leaders by introducing a unique approach to monitor vaccine protection each year through their sentinel surveillance network.

Sentinel Physicians now have the opportunity to contribute to monitoring the first pandemic in more than 40 years.
