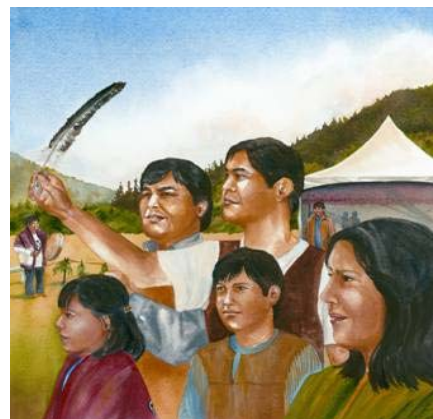
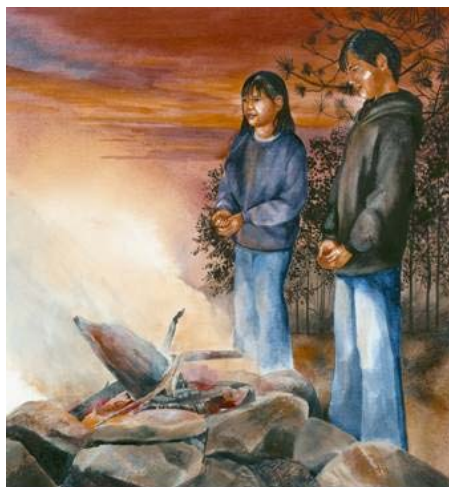
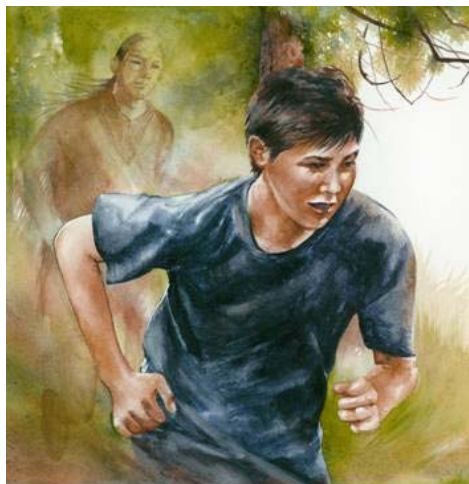


The Gathering Tree is a new, beautifully illustrated children's book about HIV/AIDS.
