## STI/HIV Services

- Integrated STI, HIV, and HCV care with 30,000 points of service per year, providing low barrier services for core populations
- STI/HIV prevention, including providing HIV PrEP and research on new interventions
- Coordinate centralized syphilis follow-up, and provide STI consulting services
  - Provide teaching for nurses, medical residents, and fellows
- Develop provincial guidelines and decision support tools for nursing practice

## Epidemiology & Surveillance

- Develop integrated surveillance systems across STI, HIV, TB, and hepatitis B & C
  - Develop and report on indicators for provincial strategies
- Provide timely access to surveillance data and quarterly reports
- Conduct enhanced analyses of surveillance and testing data

## **TB Services**

- Provide consulting services for TB, including support for First Nations Health Authority and Yukon
- Manage majority of active TB cases in BC
- Coordinate case management of drug-resistant TB and complex pediatric cases
  - Provide ~25,000 points of service in Lower Mainland, and ~800 TB clinic visits a month
  - Offer testing, diagnosis, and treatment to marginalized individuals exposed to TB in urban and rural/remote areas
  - Lead implementation of the TB Strategic Plan
    - Incorporate digital solutions into TB care
- Develop and maintain provincial guidelines and decision support tools for nursing practice

## **Hepatitis Services**

- Operate Hepatitis Education Canada with resources for patients and providers
- Develop public health guidelines for hepatitis B & C, and knowledge products
- Generate evidence to inform policies and programming through the BC Hepatitis Testers Cohort

- Design, develop, implement, and evaluate innovative digital public health services
- Support digital public health efforts of Clinical Prevention Services programs
