Re: Revisions to the Communicable Disease Control (CDC) Manual - Chapter 6: Surveillance of Reportable Conditions,

Disease-Specific Provincial Surveillance Forms, Sexually Transmitted & Blood Borne Infections, Gonorrhea and Chlamydia (HLTH208)

Please note the HLTH208 (Confidential Notification of Sexually Transmitted Infection) provincial surveillance form has been revised:

- The HLTH208 form has been updated to include the following treatment options for Uncomplicated Gonorrhea Infection, in accordance with the newly updated <u>BC Treatment</u> Guidelines for Sexually Transmitted Infections:
  - Ceftriaxone 500mg IM in a single dose (preferred)
  - Cefixime 800mg PO in a single dose plus Doxycycline 100mg PO BID x 7 days
  - Cefixime 800mg PO in a single dose plus Azithromycin 1g PO in a single dose
- The option to indicate "Other Treatment" has been removed from the gonorrhea section as a means to encourage providers to follow current guidance.
