## **Vaccine Specific Billing by Physicians**

Physicians administering publicly funded vaccines can bill for this service using the MSP fee codes contained in the MSC Payment Schedule issued by the Ministry of Health, 3. <u>General Services</u>.

Vaccines given to people <u>under 19 years of age</u> should be billed using the vaccine specific billing code; these range from 10010 through 10029 depending on the vaccine administered.

Vaccines given to those <u>aged 19 and older</u> should be billed using the appropriate code based on the route of administration (intramuscular injection B00010 or subcutaneous injection B00034)
