Re: Revisions to Communicable Disease Control Manual:

Chapter 1 - Management of Specific Diseases, Rabies

Numerous minor updates were made throughout Chapter 1– Management of Specific Diseases, Rabies to capture programmatic and administrative changes. Changes of note are highlighted here:

Page 3, Section 3.0

Figure 1 was modified to include new guidance as per Section 3.2.1.

Page 5, Section 3.1

Table 1 was modified to include a gradient of risk and to separate BC exposures from exposures occurring outside BC.

Pages 9-10, Section 3.2.1

This section was revised to provide criteria to assist in determining if animal observation is required.

Pages 15-16, Section 4.2

This section was revised to clarify the rationale for why RPEP should not be delayed beyond 48 hours.

A footnote was added to explain that a literature review was conducted to assess the duration of time after an exposure during which Rablg remains effective.
