Influenza Vaccines

- Intended Use of Influenza Vaccines
 - FLUZONE® QUADRIVALENT has been added to the list of influenza vaccines that are publicly-funded for the 2017/18 season. This vaccine has also been added to the table indicating its intended use for eligible children 6 months to 17 years of age (inclusive), and for those 18 years of age and older in the event of a surplus of FLUZONE® QUADRIVALENT in the provider's inventory beyond that required for those under 18 years old.
 - The FLUZONE® High-Dose Question and Answer document for health care providers has been updated to reflect Manitoba's decision to offer FLUZONE® High-Dose to residents of long term care facilities 65 years of age and older.
