COVID-19 mRNA Vaccine SPIKEVAX Bivalent™ (Moderna) Original/Omicron BA.4/5

Content under INDICATIONS has been revised as this vaccine is now approved by Health Canada for use as a booster dose in individuals 6 years of age and older. The associated footnotes have also been removed.

Mpox Vaccine

Smallpox and Mpox Vaccine (Live attenuated, non-replicating): IMVAMUNE®

- Content under ADMINISTRATION has been updated to indicate that once thawed, the vaccine can be stored in the refrigerator at +2°C to +8°C for up to two months.
- The guidance to wait for a period of at least 14 days between administration of IMVAMUNE® and another live or inactivated vaccine has been removed from SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS. IMVAMUNE® can be co-administered or given at any time before or after other live or inactivated vaccines.
