Content under ADMINISTRATION has been clarified to indicate that once thawed, the vaccine can be stored in the refrigerator at $+2^{\circ}$ C to $+8^{\circ}$ C for up to 8 weeks (56 days). The 8 weeks (56 days) does not include any time stored at -25° C to -15° C.
