

Influenza Activity Level by Health Authority

- The epidemic peak has passed but influenza activity remains above seasonal levels in BC
- Influenza positivity at the BCCDC Public Health Laboratory continued to decline, falling to below 35% in week 5 from a peak of more than 50% in week 52
- This trend was driven by declining A(H3N2) activity
- · Influenza B has predominated among influenza detections (>60%) this week with activity levels for
