

- Influenza activity returned to seasonal levels in most regions following several weeks of above expected rates
- Influenza positivity at the BCCDC Public Health Laboratory continued to decline, falling to below 30% in week 7 from a peak of more than 50% in week 52
- This trend was driven by declining A(H3N2) activity
- · Influenza B has predominated among influenza B remaining stable around 20%
