Ongoing, low level influenza activity continues in BC

 Although some surveillance indicators remain elevated for this time of year, influenza activity has declined substantially following the epidemic peak Influenza positivity at the BCCDC Public Health

Laboratory declined to 22% in week 14

Influenza positivity


• Influenza B comprised more than half (57%) of all influenza detections in week 14

• Among influenza A detections, A(H3N2) remains the dominant subtype; however, A(H1N1)pdm09 has also been detected
