## **BC Influenza Surveillance**

2017 - 2018 Season Week 2 (January 7 to January 13, 2018)

 Most surveillance indicators remained stable at elevated levels

· It is not yet possible to determine whether the epidemic has peaked

· Influenza positivity at the BCCDC Public Health Laboratory remained >40% but declined slightly from a peak of >50% in week 52


• An equal mix of influenza types A and B continue to circulate with A(H3N2) remaining the dominant subtype among influenza A detections
