




Number of reported cases of enteric diseases, BC, 2009





Burden of SE in BC

- 1170 cases of SE infection reported in 2007-2009
- Only cases who see physician and get stool tested are reported (approx. 1/25 cases of Salmonella)
- Equivalent to nearly 30,000 actual cases of SE in the community in 2007-2009
