Re: <u>Update to Section VII- Biological Products</u>

Please remove and destroy Section VII-Biological Products pages 64-65 dated February 2013.

Please replace with Section VII-Biological Products pages 64-65 dated September 2013.

The following changes have been made to the pages:

1. Indications:

Indications 1-8 have been condensed for clarity to read:

- Reinforcing dose in Grade 9.
- Previously unimmunized or incompletely immunized children (≥ 7 years of age), adolescents and adults, including those with unknown immunization history.
- Select special populations as indicated in <u>Section III-Immunization of Special Populations</u>.

No indications have been deleted or changed.

Additional indications section added:

RECOMMENDED BY THE NATIONAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON IMMUNIZATION BUT NOT PROVIDED FREE IN BC:

 All adults ≥ 18 years of age should receive one dose, if not previously immunized in adulthood.

2. Reinforcements:

Removed: Not publicly funded for booster immunization of those ≥18 years old. This content moved to indications sections.

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3. Contraindications revised to read:

History of Guillain-Barré syndrome (GBS) within 8 weeks of receipt of a tetanus containing vaccine without any other cause being identified.

4. Product components:

Now listed specifically for each vaccine- Boostrix and Adacel.

5. Footnotes condensed and moved into main text blocks as stated above.
Footnote A: added information on requirements for grade 9 Tdap dose if a dose was given at > 10 years of age.

This is consistent with the grade 9 consent form and is a programmatic decision.
