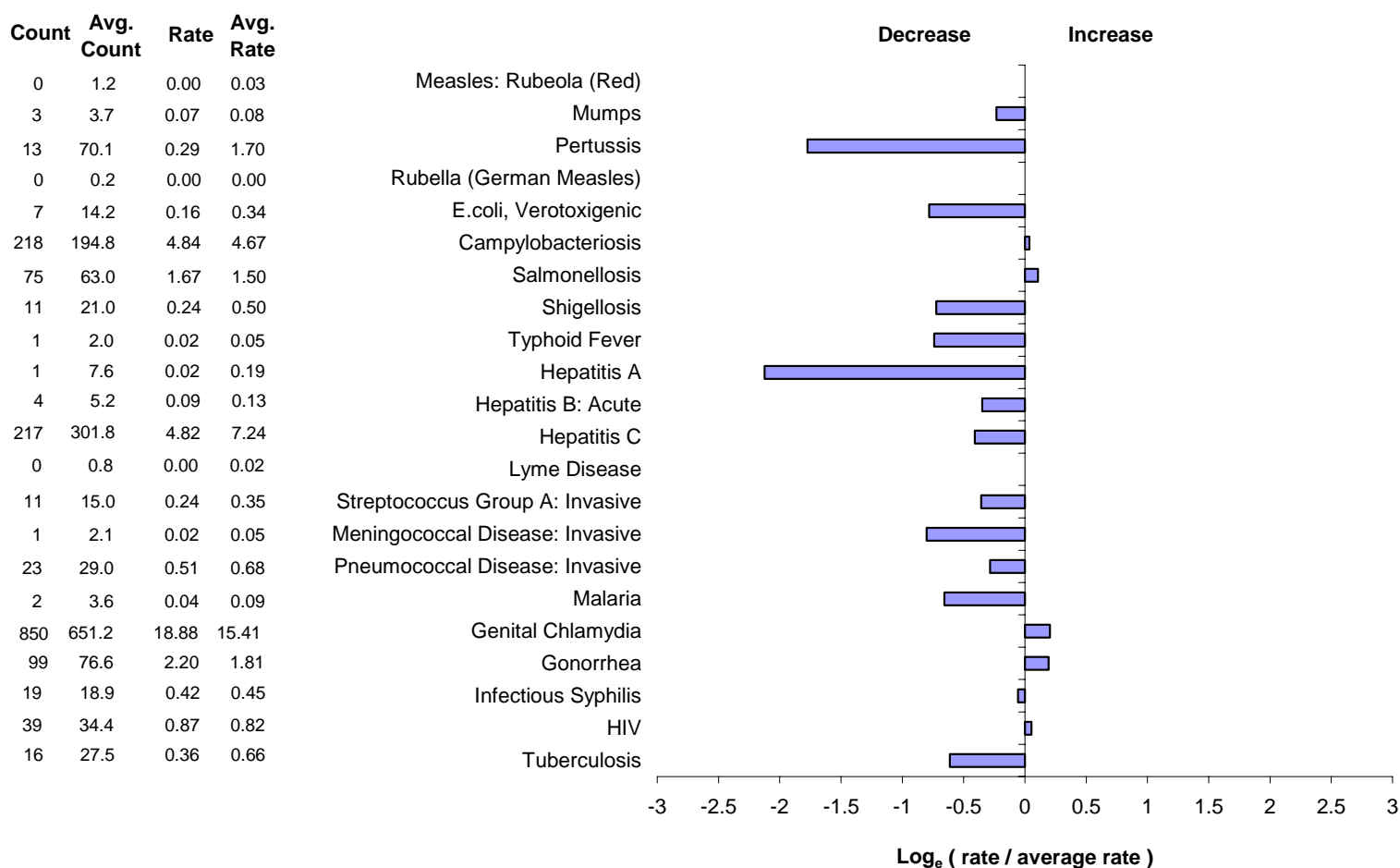


Monthly Incidence of Selected Communicable Diseases

Selected Communicable Diseases Monthly Report June 2009

| Measure: | The ratio (in natural log scale) of the monthly incidence rate to the average of the 30 months (from previous, same, and subsequent months for the past 10 years ¹) for selected communicable diseases ² across British Columbia based on reportable disease notifications to BCCDC from Health Authorities. |
| Limitations: | These reports are based on passively notified case reports made to local public health authorities. There may be incomplete reporting or delayed reporting. The ratio cannot be established for diseases with no cases in either the current month or the historical comparable months. The log ratio does not offer direct interpretation for the magnitude of increase or decrease in incidence rate. |
