Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The interim guidelines for public health management of cases and contacts associated with novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in the community have been revised.

Zoonotic Transmission

- Updated to indicate that:
 - Outbreaks of SARS-CoV-2 in mink have been detected on mink farms in Europe (Denmark, the Netherlands, Spain) and in the United States (Utah).
 - Bats, dogs, non-human primates and rabbits have been added to the list of animals for which there is evidence of some level of susceptibility to infection with SARS-CoV-2.

 Flight exposures: Case name and symptom onset date have been added to the information that should be sent to the BCCDC in the notification of a COVID-19 case on a flight.

Appendix 4

 Content has been broadened to include guidance related to COVID-19 exposure, cluster, & outbreak management in school and daycares.
