COIVD-19 Vaccine After Care Sheet

The After Care Sheet has been revised as follows:

- Recommendations for health care workers (HCWs) have been clarified to indicate that HCWs, including those working in assisted living facilities, who experience any symptoms compatible with COVID-19 need to use the <u>BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment</u> <u>Tool</u> to determine if they need to get tested.
- Content added regarding the length of time to develop immunity following the first dose of vaccine.
- Information related to the Canadian National Vaccine Safety (CANVAS) Network, a national platform that monitors vaccine safety after vaccines are approved for use, has been added.
- Language and organization of the content have been modified to reduce the literacy level of the resource.
