Updates

The SURVEILLANCE AND REPORTING section has been updated to reflect the current COVID-19 case reporting processes. As of April 1, 2022, local public health is no longer required to directly report COVID-19 cases to BCCDC. Confirmed cases are reported to BCCDC via positive PCR results from laboratory data, which are linked to hospitalization and Vital Statistics data.
