• The eligibility table has been revised for the primary series for immunocompetent and moderately to severely immunocompromised pediatric populations 5-11 years of age to include the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine. Content has been included to indicate that the Moderna vaccine is only for those 6-11 years of age.

## COVID-19 Vaccine COMIRNATY® (Pfizer-BioNTech) (Adult/Adolescent)

• Doses and Schedule:

The content for footnote B that read "... (with the exception of those 18-29 years of age who are moderately to severely immunosuppressed...)..." has been revised to 12-29 years of age to be consistent with current recommendations.

  - The content in footnote A has been revised to be inclusive of the use of Moderna vaccine in those 6-11 years of age.
