Influenza Vaccines

2022/23 Seasonal Influenza Vaccines

- Revisions to the influenza pages include:
 - New product pages have been added for AFLURIA® TETRA and FLULAVAL® TETRA. Note that AFLURIA® TETRA is not approved for use in those less than 5 years of age.
 - The "Intended Use of Influenza Vaccines" table has been revised to include AFLURIA® TETRA and FLULAVAL® TETRA.
 - The content under Contraindications regarding a 4 week interval between receipt of influenza vaccine and a CTLA-4 inhibitor alone or in combination with other checkpoint inhibitors has been removed to align with current <u>BC Cancer Influenza</u> vaccine recommendations.
