
## **BC Influenza Surveillance**

2018 - 2019 Season Week 41 (October 7 to October 13, 2018)


- Influenza activity in BC was at low levels in week 41
- Influenza positivity at the BCCDC Public Health Laboratory remained low, peaking at 3%;
- There have been no influenza B detections since week 30;
- Among low level detections, the A(H1N1)pdm09 subtype has been most common, but with A(H3N2) contributing more also in recent weeks, requiring ongoing monitoring;
- Other community ILI indicators were at or below expected seasonal levels

## Virus Subtype by Age (2018-19 Season YTD)








## Influenza Activity Level by Health Authority
