Part 2 of a 3-part series



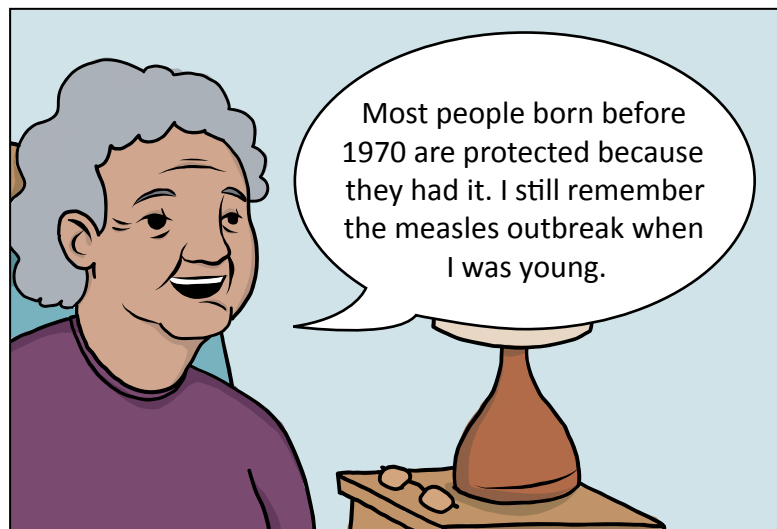
"Kookum, did you hear? Ben's son, Joe, has measles now. Ben called the clinic ahead of time so they could prepare before seeing Joe."



"It's so contagious, Joe needs to stay home at least 4 days. Apparently, it can be passed on before symptoms even show up."



"Yes, it can spread fast. Many years ago, measles devastated Indigenous communities across Turtle Island. Entire villages were lost. Vaccines can help stop this from happening again."



"Make sure the rest of the family gets vaccinated though. This will protect you and everyone around you."
