"Uncle, Sage wants me to get tested for sexually transmitted infections (STIs). I'm nervous. Are they going to ask a lot of personal questions?"

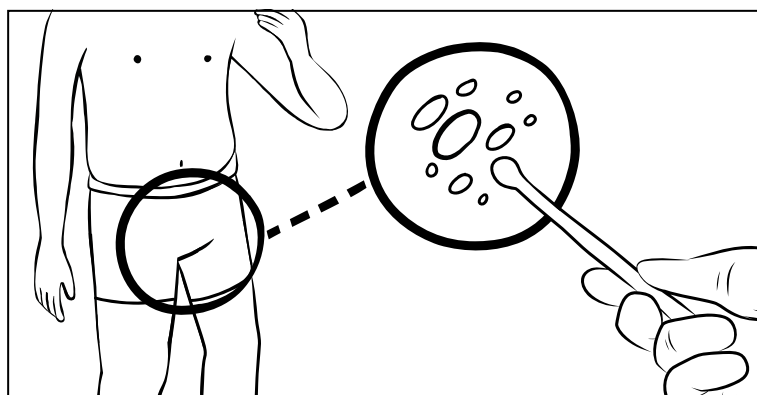


They'll ask a few questions about your sex life. And then they will recommend what kind of tests you'll need.

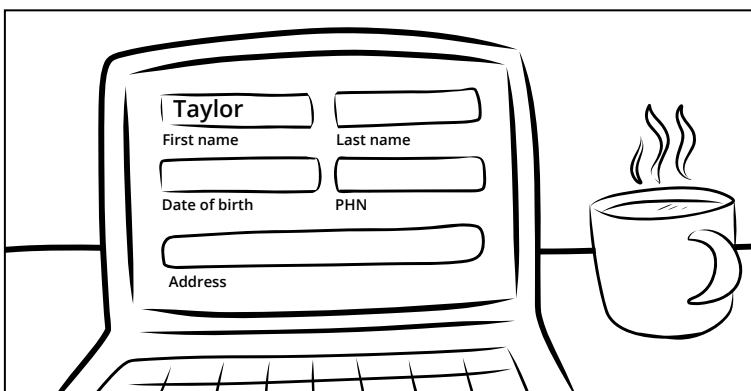
Okay. But is it going to hurt?



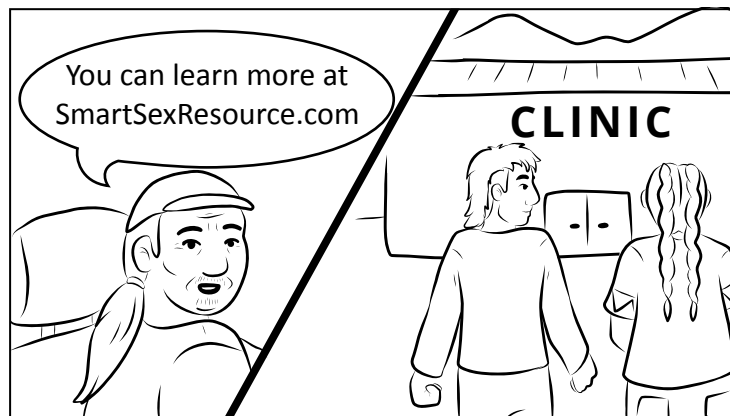
"Depends on what the test is for. Most of the time, you're peeing into a cup or giving a blood sample."
